The Government of Kenya has received financing from the World Bank toward the cost of the Eastern Electricity Highway Project, and intends to apply part of the proceeds for the above-mentioned consulting services.

The consulting services (“the Services”) include:

- Review of feasibility study report, Detailed Engineering Design, Works Contracts Documentation and Procurement,
- Carry out precise Engineering survey for high voltage electricity transmission lines and associated substations,
- To conduct soil investigation along the proposed transmission line routes and substations,
- Preparation and submission to KETRACO and the World Bank of a detailed project implementation schedule.

The **Kenya Electricity Transmission Company Limited (KETRACO)** now invites eligible consulting firms (“Consultants”) to indicate their interest in providing the Services. Interested Consultants should provide information demonstrating that they have the required qualifications and relevant experience to perform the Services. The shortlisting criteria are:

- Alignment of core business area of the applicant firm with the subject assignment;
- At least fifteen (15) years relevant experience in the field of High Voltage power system infrastructure consultancy and project management of EPC contracts with successful delivery of at least five (5) similar assignments and preferably two (2) of them in Sub-Saharan Africa (SSA). (Relevant completion certificates and/or letters of recommendation from clients to be provided)
- Successful completion of at least three (3) similar assignments in High voltage overhead line Engineering Survey works within SSA, and preferably one (1) in Kenya (Relevant completion certificates and/or letters of recommendation from clients to be provided),
- Successful delivery of at least three (3) similar nature and complexity assignments in High voltage overhead line that includes geotechnical investigation Consultancy services within SSA and preferably one (1) in Kenya (Relevant completion certificates and/or letters of recommendation from clients to be provided),

The attention of interested Consultants is drawn to paragraph 1.9 of the World Bank’s Guidelines: Selection and Employment of Consultants under IBRD Loans and IDA Credits and Grants by World Bank January 2011, revised July 2014 (“Consultant Guidelines”), setting forth the World Bank’s policy on conflict of interest.
