

## **Invitation for Bids (IFB)**

- 1. The Government of the Republic of Kenya (GoK) has applied for financing from the African Development Fund (ADF) towards the cost of the Kenya Tanzania Power Interconnection Project. It is intended that part of the proceeds of this financing will be applied to eligible payments under the contracts for Plant Design, Supply, Construction, Installation and Commissioning of Lot K2: Rural Electrification along the 400kV Kenya -Tanzania Power Interconnection Project (KTPIP)
- 2. The Kenya Electricity Transmission Company Limited (KETRACO) hereinafter referred to as the "Employer," invites sealed bids from the qualified firms for the execution of the following works under this project: Electrification along the 400kV Kenya -Tanzania Power Interconnection Project (KTPIP).

The major works to be carried out by the Contractor shall comprise of but not be limited to the following:

- Electrification of villages along the 400kV Kenya-Tanzania Interconnection Project. This part of the
  project consists of design, manufacture, test, supply, erection and commissioning of 33kV, 3 phase lines
  with different equipment such as re-closers, fuse cutout and distribution transformers etc.
- Lot K2 has approximately 132km of 33 kV lines and about 50km of 400V to be constructed.
   Also included are about, 32 transformers of 50kVA and 2 transformers of 100kVA to be installed and services lines and meters to about 7,000 customers.

International Competitive Bidding (ICB) method with "Single Stage" Bidding Procedures will be followed in accordance with the Bank's Rules and Procedures for Procurement of Goods and Works.
